At Norge endelig gjenåpnet i tide før vår auksjon siste helgen i november på Grand Hotel i hovedstaden, var en gledens dag for svært mange, og jeg vil også tro for alle landets numismatikere. Auksjoner har fungert utmerket også digitalt, men det er tross alt noe annet å kunne møtes og være tilstede i det sosiale livet som en vanlig auksjon bringer med seg. Vi vet godt at numismatikerne både her hjemme og utenfor våre grenser har vært meget aktive også i disse spesielle tidene, men møteplassen som en storaauksjon i Oslo Myntgalleris regi er, gir en ekstra spiss på det hele. Og har du ikke mulighet til å komme til oss disse to dagene, vet du at vi alltid tar godt vare på alle liebabere som jakter på det spennende utvalget vi kan presentere også denne gang.

Antallet norske specier vi kan presentere understrekker dette. Hele 94 objekter av denne typen legges ut på auksjonen, flere av dem hører til våre største sjeldenheter. Den første jeg vil trekke frem er specien fra 1628. Det er mynten som har fått tilnavnet «den ville løven», nettopp fordi løven her ser litt mer vill ut enn ellers. Dette var den første pregingen i Christiania med sølv fra Kongsberg, og det er kjent under 10 eksemplarer i privat eie. I kvaliteten 1+ er utropet NOK 125 000.

½-specien fra 1649, kanskje den mest sjeldne av alle våre specier med bare 3 kjente i privat eie, er som de fleste vet den mynten som setter en stopper for de fleste som skryter av myntsamlingen sin. Med spørsmålet «Hvor mange ½-specier fra Frederik III har du egentlig?», blir det som regel stille hos de fleste. Nå har du altså sjansen til å sikre deg ett eksemplar, slik at du enkelt kan svare «jeg har en» når spørsmålet blir stilt. Utropsprisen er satt til NOK 250 000.

Specien fra 1826 er også spesiell fordi det er den bærer gravørens signatur. Det var billedhuggeren Gregorius Middelthun som graverde mynten, og det ble hans eneste oppgave i numismatikken. Han graverde den med for høyt relief slik at eksemplarene aldri ble fullpreget. Dette eksemplaret stammer fra Helge Reffs sagnomsuste samling og har et utrop på NOK 150 000. Norske dukater er også ekstremt sjeldne, derfor er vi ekstra glade for at du nå får muligheten til å sikre deg et eksemplar av dukaten fra ca. 1675 som kun er kjent i 6 eksemplarer, også denne har i sin tid tilhørt Helge Reff.

Det er imidlertid ikke bare norske gull- og sølvmyntsjeldenheter denne auksjonen kan by på. Spesielt glade

er vi for at vi kan legge ut for salg den store kobbermynten 4-skillingen fra 1810. Den finnes det bare 2 kjente eksemplarer i privat eie, og dette eksemplaret har en virkelig interessant historie. Den dukket opp i USA; sannsynligvis har den i sin tid fulgt med en norsk utvandrer til det forjettede nye land. I 1891 ble mynten gitt som gave til universitetet i Omaha i Nebraska, og der ble den liggende frem til 1993, da universitetet ønsket å selge mynten for å finansiere utbyggingen av sitt Western Heritage Museum. Da dukker den opp i det internasjonale auksjonshuset Spink, og nå har vi gleden av å rope ut dette ene av to kjente eksemplarer til NOK 100 000.

Krone- og øremynt-avdelingen har også mange fristelser, bl.a. en meget pen 1 krone fra 1878 i 01-kvalitet. Utropet her er satt til NOK 40 000. Avdelingen teller over 100 objekter, og ikke minst er det viktig å legge merke til alle de pene kvalitetene på 10- og 25-ørene fra 18- og 1900-tallet.

Og samler du på sedler har du nå muligheten til å sikre deg 1-specien fra 1852 hvor vi kjenner til 4 eksemplarer. 50-kronen fra 1896 skal man heller ikke overse, det er vel den peneste Oscar II-50 krone seddelen vi noen gang har sett, og det er under 10 kjente. Den eneste kjente i privat eie av 5-kronen fra Spitsbergen 1933/34 føyer seg pent inn i rekken av auksjonens sjeldenheter. Og samler du medaljer, er den store sølvmedaljen preget i 1718 i forbindelse med Karl XII's død et herlig objekt. Dette er faktisk en «mobbemedalje» mot svenskene, bare les inskripsjonen!!

Også utenlandsavdelingen og avdelingen med klassikere fra antikken vil ganske sikkert trekke mange denne helgen. Den danske avdelingen kan skilte med en rekke fine sølvmynter fra 1500-tallet og fremover, og en 4-dukat gull preget i Tyskland i 1617 til 100-års jubileet for reformasjonen vil nok friste mange. En rekke senromerske og bysantinske gullmynter avslutter det hele, her er det ettersøkte objekter du sjeldent ser på en norsk auksjon.

Så la meg derfor avslutte som jeg begynte: Endelig kan vi møtes igjen, endelig kan vi bli *sosiale* numismatikere! Og en bedre åpning på «De nye tider» enn vår auksjon 27. og 28. november tror jeg neppe du finner.

AUKSJONSBETINGELSER

1. Følgende auksjonsbetingelser gjelder for alle budgivere som deltar på auksjonene til Oslo Myntgalleri AS. Ved å gi bud så forplikter man seg til å følge auksjonsreglement. Auksjonen er offentlig og frivillig. Hvis ikke annet er opplyst vil det være flere innleverere til auksjonen.
2. Oslo Myntgalleri er pliktig til å utvise nøyaktighet og aktsomhet i beskrivelsen av auksjonobjektene. Ethvert objekt anses for autentisk og fra perioden som beskrevet hvis det ikke er gitt uttrykk for annet. Det er ingen utløpsdato for ekthetsgarantien.
3. Alle objekter selges i den tilstand som beskrevet og fremvist før auksjonsstart. Kjøperne har selv anledning til å besiktige objektene før auksjonen, og eventuelle reklamasjoner etter klubbeslag vil derfor ikke bli akseptert. Auksjonshusets ansvar er begrenset på samme måte for de som har gitt forhåndsbud eller bud per telefon.

Avgiftspliktige objekter er merket med* ved objektnumeret. All innenlands postforsendelse skjer for mottagers regning og risiko. Oslo myntgalleri tilbyr imidlertid forsikring av forsendelser mot et gebyr. Alle forsendelser til utlandet sendes med DHL eller Fedex (minimumspris i Europa NOK 350,-). For alle utenlandssendinger tilkommer også et automatisk forsikringsgebyr på minimum NOK 100,-. Kjøper står selv ansvarlig for å oppgi riktig adresse for fakturering og forsendelse, og Oslo Myntgalleri står ikke ansvarlig for feiladresserte forsendelser som skyldes manglende eller feilaktig informasjon fra kjøper.
13. All betaling må skje i NOK (norske kroner) og kjøpesummen må være godskrevet vår konto senest 7 dager etter at faktura er utstedt. Ved forsinket betaling påløper 1 % rente pr. påbegynt måned. Hvis betaling ikke er godskrevet auksjonshusets konto innen 30 dager etter at auksjonen er avholdt, kan auksjonsobjektet selges for kjøpers regning og risiko. 

1. The following terms and conditions apply to bidders of all auctions held by Oslo Myntgalleri AS. By making a bid, the bidder agrees to our terms and conditions and accepts to be bound by them. The auction is open to the public and all participation is voluntary. Unless otherwise stated, there will be more than one consignor.
2. It is the duty of the auctioneer to give accurate and honest descriptions of all objects. Unless otherwise stated, all items are guaranteed authentic and from the period as described. There is no expiration time to this guarantee.
3. All items are sold in the condition as described in the catalogue and shown prior to the auction. All bidders should appraise and inspect the items prior to the auction. Consequently, complaints about grades and quality of the items will not be accepted. This restriction to complaints also applies to absentee bidders.
4. All bids are binding, and bidders must be of legal capacity, i.e., at least 18 years old.
5. Written pre-bids must be delivered to the auctioneer in due time before the auction. Telephone bidding is only accepted for lots with starting prices above NOK 2000, -. All clients must make preliminary agreements with Oslo Myntgalleri at least 24 hours before the auction starts.
6. Although the auction is to be conducted carefully, the auctioneer is not responsible for possible mistakes or misunderstandings on the part of the buyer.
7. The auctioneer may refuse to accept bids from a person unknown or without proper references. Foreign customers should register several days prior to the auction date in order to be accepted as bidders.
8. The auctioneer has the right to deny a person to take part in the auction. He may also withdraw, rearrange or divide items. In case of disagreements during auction, the auctioneer may restart bidding one or more lots in order to settle a dispute.
9. Agents bidding on behalf of clients are fully responsible for settling the payment of any purchased items. The auctioneer may hold both agent and third-party clients responsible for unsettled payments.
10. All bids are given in Norwegian kroner and all items are sold to the highest bidder. In case of identical bids, the first bid will be prioritized. In case of identical bids from the Room and Internet, the Room bids will be prioritized.
11. Graded coins and banknotes: We do not give any warranty for the authenticity or possible defects on graded coins in slabs and other holders from third party companies.
12. The prices in the catalogue are minimum prices and lower bids will not be accepted. A buyer's premium of 20 % is added to the hammer price of each item. On medals sold to foreign customers, the buyer's premium is 25 %. All coins and banknotes that are or have been legal tender are exempted from VAT in Norway. On all other items, like medals and tokens, 25 % VAT is added to the buyer's premium. Lots that are subjected to VAT is marked with * by the end of the lot number. Please note that the auctioneer is not responsible for additional import VAT issued by authorities in other countries. All domestic shipping happens on the risk of the buyer. However, Oslo Myntgalleri offers insured shipments for an additional fee. All international shipments will be sent with DHL or Fedex at a minimum price of NOK 350, -. All international shipments are automatically insured at an additional fee of minimum NOK 100, -. Oslo Myntgalleri is not responsible for shipments that are lost due to wrong or insufficient address information provided by the buyer.
13. All payments must be done in NOK (Norwegian Krone). The sale is completed upon receipt of payment, at the latest 7 days after the bidder has received the invoice. In the case of later payment, 1 % interest is added at the beginning of every month. The buyer is responsible for paying all bank charges and shipping and insurance costs. If payment has not been received within 30 days after the auction, the auctioneer reserves the right to sell any unpaid item(s) if necessary. The auctioneer alone will decide how such sale is conducted and the sale will always be at the risk/cost of the original buyer. Such sales may take place without further notice and the original buyer is responsible for any economic loss due to lost commission or reduced sale price.

Demetrios I Poliorketes was a colorful person, gaining much fame by defeating the Ptolemaic fleet at Salamis off Cyprus in 306 BC. He became popular in Athens when ousting Kassander, but his popularity vanished when he made his camp at the sacred Acropolis, feasting with dancing ladies and loud bands. He met his end fighting Lysimachos and Seleukos in Asia Minor and died in captivity in 283 BC. His descendants nevertheless ruled Macedon until the last king Perseus was defeated by the romans in 168 BC. The coin offered here shows a remarkable portrait of the ageing king on the obverse and an intriguing reverse celebrating his naval victory at Salamis.

Aigai is situated on a hilltop, some miles inland from Kyme and Myrina on the western coast of modern Turkey. It controlled the roads to Sardes and Pergamon. The city is relatively well preserved today, taking into consideration that it was founded by Greeks, occupied and fortified by Persians, used as a Roman garrison and finally used by the Byzantines. Remnants of all occupants can still be seen. Aigai had a very limited output of stephanophoric tetradrachms compared to Kyme and Myrina and the coins are very rare today. According to Westermark, only four obverse dies are known (cf. U. Westermark, "En tetradrachm från Aigai i Aiolis" in Festschrift Lagerqvist, pp. 471-5).

In July 44 BC ancient sources describe a massive seven-day commentary outburst that appeared on the sky. The outburst must have been a true spectacle for the ancient observers and modern studies claim the comet to be the brightest daylight comet in all historical records. For ancient romans, the comet rain was a clear sign of the deification of the recently assassinated dictator Julius Caesar. The comet became known as the Sidus Iulium ("Julian Star") and was believed to be the soul of Caesar. The comet became an important symbol for Caesar's great-nephew and adopted son Augustus who associated himself with the divine Julius, and he used the comet for his own propaganda. The denarius offered here is a fine specimen with an elaborate portrait of Augustus on the obverse and the Julian Star on the reverse.



The reign of Theodosius I (AD 379-395) marked a turning point in the history of the Roman Empire, and his strict but efficient rule brought changes that reshaped the western world. He was the last sole ruler of the whole empire which after his death was split into a western and eastern part by his sons Honorius and Arcadius. Never again would the whole empire be ruled by one emperor and the western part soon succumbed to barbarian invasions.

Theodosius is well-known for his Christian reforms suppressing paganism and Arianism. He used his power to enforce the universal norm for orthodox Christianity, the new state religion. In AD 381 he arranged a meeting in Constantinople revising and clarifying the creed of the Council of Nicaea in AD 325. Theodosius closed the pagan temples and outlawed all forms of pagan worship and festivities throughout the empire. An edict even prohibited public discussions of religious questions. The Olympic Games, now declared pagan and non-Christian, were held for the last time in AD 393. The tradition was finally brought back to life in 1896 when the first modern Olympic Games were arranged in Athens. In AD 380, Theodosius declared Sunday to be a day of worship and rest, a tradition that is still practiced in many Christian countries around the world to this day.

Heraclius Constantine (Constantine III) ascended the throne as co-emperor with his father Heraclius on January 22, AD 641. His father died from disease just a few weeks later and was worn out by endless wars on the frontiers fighting against Slavs, Avars, Arabs and Persians. Heraclius Constantine himself was of poor health and died just three months after ascending the throne. The cause of death was probably tuberculosis. His rule was the shortest of any byzantine emperor and he had reigned together with his younger half-brother Heraclonas from February that year. His short reign and aftermath were filled with dynastic struggles between his own son Constans II and Heraclonas who both wanted the throne for themselves. After his father died, Constans II and his supporters managed to set up a scheme accusing Heraclonas and his mother Martina for poisoning Heraclius Constantine. The plot succeeded and Heraclonas, Martina and the rest of her sons were deposed and exiled. Their punishments were cruel. Heraclonas got his nose cut off and Martina got her tongue split. The rest of her sons were castrated.

The coinage from the short reign of Heraclius Constantine and Heraclonas has been much discussed by scholars. The general opinion is that the coins should be assigned to the succeeding emperor Constans II. However, there are a few good arguments against this theory. The period shows a rapid evolution in portrait types on the solidus, much more than what was common during the reign of a single emperor. Such rapid changes were generally avoided for the important solidus, as it was the most trusted trading coin in the region and a corner stone of Byzantine imperial administration and control. The rare varieties of portrait solidi might thus be explained as symbols of power from short-lived emperors. The specimen offered here is an extremely rare coin, and the third specimen registered in the online auction records from the past 20 years. This is the only specimen with officina letter B and is not listed in DOC or any other major reference works.
